TORNADO HELP FOR EVERYONE AFFECTED from FEMA. Have you heard the rumor that homeowners with insurance are not eligible for FEMA? That's not true! FEMA agents are canvassing the city, encouraging everyone affected to apply for assistance, whether homeowners or renters, insured or not. FEMA can function as a Plan B for costs not covered by insurance. All applicants receive notification that approval is pending additional information (read your letter to the end, past the word "declined") and are encouraged to complete the application and even appeal to keep their application open for several years to accommodate future needs. What does this mean? Please talk with your friends and family to share the news that help is available from the church, and from state and federal agencies!
